All **entries open** at 8:00 A.M., Monday, August 18, 2003 at the Test Secretary's home. No entries will be accepted before this time. All **entries close** at 6:00 P.M., Wednesday, September 24, 2003 at the Test Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC *Herding Regulations*. When numerical limits are exceeded, additional entries will be placed on alternates list. Drawing for running order will be held at 6:30 P.M., September 24, 2003 at the Test Secretary's home.

Instinct Test entries **will be** accepted day of test. There will be a limit of forty (40) total runs. Exhibition Only entries will be accepted, with the same fee and closing date as regular entries.

## Notice to Exhibitors

- Hand-carried entries will be accepted.
- Make checks or money orders payable to the Puli Club of America (or PCA). All fees are payable in U.S. funds.
- Drawing for running order will be held at the Test Secretary's home on Wednesday, September 24, 2003 at 6:30 P.M.
- There shall be no refund of entry fees for dogs that are absent, retired, removed, excused or disqualified or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or compete in the Test. If a dog is absent and is replaced by an alternate, then the entry fee shall be refunded.
- Entrants on the alternate's list must check in with the Herding Secretary on the Test grounds no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their class. Alternates that do not have the opportunity to run shall have the entry fee refunded.
- Requests to move-up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run in catalog order in Test classes but will be placed at the end of the running order in Test classes.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25 collection fee will be added to each returned check.
- No refunds will be made for duplicated entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such.
- The Puli Club of America may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the Puli Club of America or any official thereof.
- The Test site is in the Eastern Time zone.
- There will be an hour's lunch break at the judge's discretion.
- **No food will be available on site.**
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself. We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the Test location as clean as possible in order to be able to hold future AKC events at this facility.
- The initial handlers' meeting will be held at 8:15 A.M. each day. Subsequent handlers' meetings will be held before each class.
- A separate entry must be made for each class.
- All dogs must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when competing. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the *AKC Herding Regulations*.
- This is a working farm, please take care to close and latch all gates.
- Please remember to bring shade, water, chairs and raingear.
- The Puli Club of America, its officers and representatives, the Test Chair, Secretary, Committee and the owner of the Test site assume no responsibility for loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors' property and their dogs and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. Owners or handlers entering a dog in the Test or Test do so at their own risk and also agree to abide by the Rules of The American Kennel Club and the *AKC Herding Regulations*, amended to September 1, 2002.

## ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

PCA has adopted the following rules in order to insure that the members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future. Any individual attending a PCA Sanctioned Event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or Gampsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dogs on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or Gampsite/fairgrounds and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all the following actions by the PCA Board of Directors. 1. May be banned from showing at the next PCA sanctioned event[s]. 2. May be subject to AKC sanctions. 3. Membership in PCA may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated. DAMAGES SHALL BE DEFINED AS: 1. Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property [ walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.]. 2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground. 3. Any verified complaint by a PCA member. PCA ROOM REGULATIONS: 1. All dogs must be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog. 2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages. 3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible. 4. Dogs are to be allowed on furniture ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler. 5. All owner/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite. BY SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM, COMPLIANCE WITH THIS POLICY SHALL BE INSURED. ALL INDIVIDUALS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY.

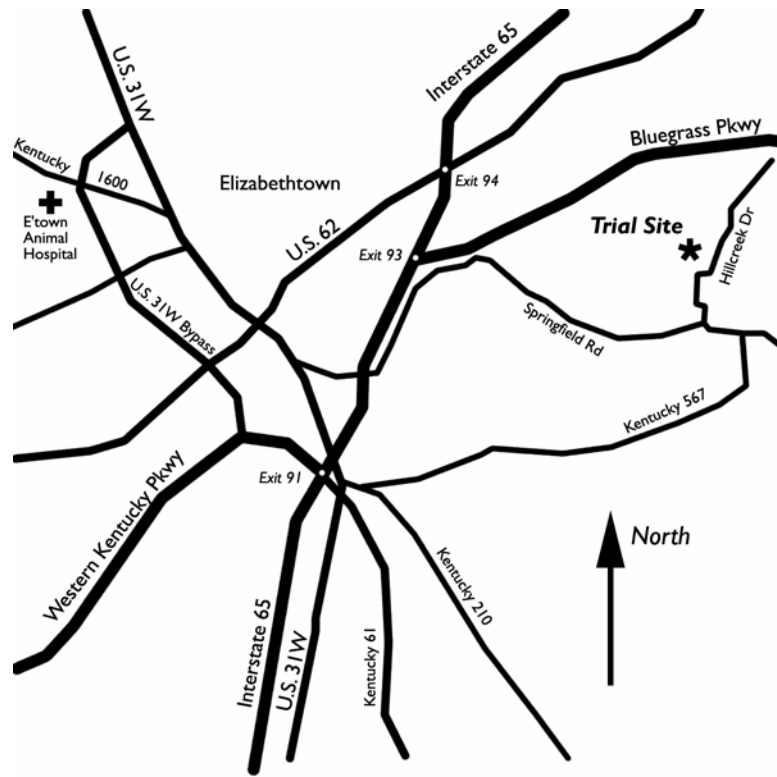

### Directions

From Bardstown, take the Bluegrass Parkway west towards Elizabethtown. Take the Parkway until it ends at Interstate 65 (Exit 1; Elizabethtown South). Take Interstate 65 south to the next interchange, which is the Elizabethtown/Hodgenville exit (#91). Follow signs as if you are going to Hodgenville until you get to the first red light, which is U.S. Route 31W. Turn left on U.S. 31W and proceed to the next light and turn right, between the Shell and Chevron stations (Kentucky 210). Go about a block and then turn left onto Kentucky 567 (Valley Creek Road). Go straight through the four-way stop sign and continue on about four miles to the Valley Creek Baptist Church. Note the cute lamb in the stained glass window. Turn left at the church onto Springfield Road, and then take the first street on the right, which is Hillcreek Drive. Hillcreek Drive is a winding country road, so be very careful of blind curves. Smokey Ridge Farm is on your left, with the name "Miller" on the mailbox and a white sign with a sheep upon it. There is a long red barn, and you will be able to see the course from the road. If you get to the dead end, you've gone too far.

If you are coming from From Louisville or north, take I-65 south. From Nashville or south, take I-65 north. From Lexington or east, take the Bluegrass Parkway west to the end, and then follow the signs to I-65 south. From Paducah and the west, take the Western Kentucky Parkway to the end, and follow the above directions from there.
