
AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to registration and Dog Shows" and the "rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damages to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the full market value (\$125.00) of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

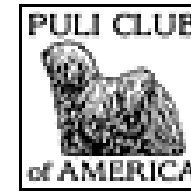
ALL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULES REGARDING CONDUCT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

- **TEST/TRIAL SITE** Will be available at 8:00am to 5:00pm each day, or one hour after conclusion of event.
- **EXHIBITORS MUST** confine crates and exercise pens to the area designated by committee. Proof of current vaccinations (Including Rabies) must be available for any dog at these events.
- **EXHIBITORS PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG AND YOURSELF!** We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the Test location as clean as possible in order to retain the use of this facility in the future. Please bring your own chairs and shade screens, as limited shade is available.
- **BITCHES IN SEASON** will run last.
- **ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEAD EXCEPT WHEN JUDGED IN THE ARENA!**
- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being on a "cash-only" basis.
- **IF ENTRIES FILL**, refunds will be made as necessary.
- **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC HERDING** forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Release Form on the reverse side of the entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

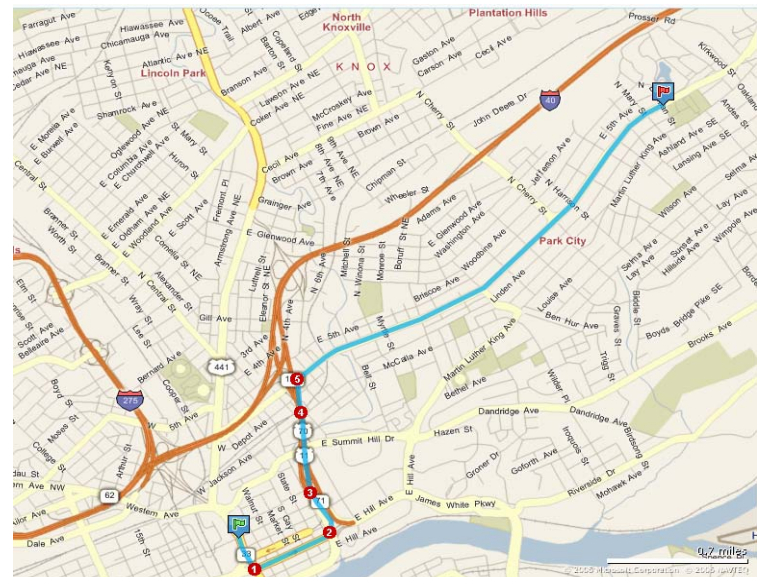

ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

PCA has adopted the following rules in order to insure that the members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future.

Any individual attending a PCA Sanctioned Event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dogs on the grounds.

Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairgrounds and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all the following actions by the PCA Board of Directors.

1. May be banned from showing at the next PCA sanctioned event[s].
2. May be subject to AKC sanctions.
3. Membership in PCA may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

DAMAGES SHALL BE DEFINED AS:

1. Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property [walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.].
2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel / campsite / fairground.
3. Any verified complaint by a PCA member.

PCA ROOM REGULATIONS:

1. All dogs must be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible.
4. Dogs are to be allowed on furniture ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.

5. All owner/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel / campsite.

BY SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM, COMPLIANCE WITH THIS POLICY SHALL BE INSURED.

ALL INDIVIDUALS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY.
