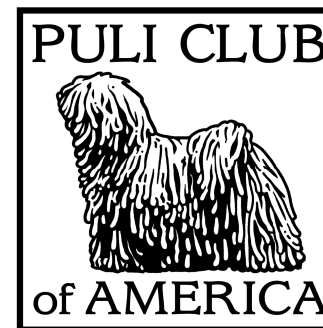

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. From Hartford

Rt 84 East exit 55 to Rt 2 East
Rt 2 to Rt 17 South (Glastonbury-Portland)
Left at Isinglass Hill Road for .7 miles.
Turn right on to Thompson Hill Road for 1.4
miles.
Turn left at Old Marlborough Turnpike .4
miles.
Turn right on South Road for .6 miles.
Farm on Right.

From South (Middletown) RT 17/Rt 66

Follow over Connecticut River into Portland.
Turn right on to Rt 66 (East) follow for 2
miles.
Turn left onto Rt 17 (North) follow for 2
miles
Turn right on to Sage Hollow Road for .3
miles.
Take slight right on to Rose Hill road for .2
miles
Turn left on to Cox Road 1.2 miles
Turn left on to South Road .3 miles
Farm on left.

Room Responsibility Policy

PCA has adopted the following rules in order to insure that the members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future. Any individual attending a PCA Sanctioned Event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dogs on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairgrounds and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all the following actions by the PCA Board of Directors.

1. May be banned from showing at the next PCA sanction event(s)
2. May be subject to AKC sanctions
3. Membership in PCA may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated

PCA Room Regulations

1. All dogs must be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
 2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
 3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible.
 4. Dogs are to be allowed on furniture ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.
 5. All owner/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.
- BY SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM, COMPLIANCE WITH THIS POLICY SHALL BE INSURED. ALL INDIVIDUALS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- Dogs under six months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
- Trial site available from 7 am to one hour after conclusion of events.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- Bitches in season will run in catalog order. Please notify Trial Secretary if your bitch is in season.
- American Kennel Club Rules regarding Conduct will be strictly enforced.
- A separate entry form for each class and each trial must be completed for each dog entered. Please fill out entry form legibly and completely. There will be no refunds for duplicate entries or errors on entry forms.
- Dogs MUST be on leash at all times, except when competing
- Please note this trial site is private property! Please keep your dogs and/or children away from the residence and its fenced yard. Do not "potty" your dogs near the fence around the house.
- Please do not throw garbage in Port-a-Potties
- Dogs must be ready for their classes. Test/Trial judges have the authority to refuse to judge any dog that does not appear within five minutes of being called for its run.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors, alone, are responsible for the behavior of their dogs/children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
