Opening date for ALL entries is Saturday July 1, 2017 at 8 am.

All entries received before this date will be returned. **Entries for Pulik will be given priority until 6pm August 15th after which time entries for all breeds will be accepted in the order they were received.** Entries close Wednesday, Sept 27, 2017 at 6 PM after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has been changed to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card, or needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. DIRECTIONS TO ARENA

Some GPS's try to bring you off Sparta pike to BeechLog - that is the back way in and it's easy to get lost. So sometimes it's easier to put in the coordinates - Corner of Beech Log Rd and Cainesville Rd N 36 degrees 05.448' W 086 degrees 14.191'

From Host Hotel

Approximately 40 minutes

Get on TN-155 s/Briely Pkwy, Take I-40 E towards Lebanon Take exit 239a Watertown, stay in right hand lane - 3/10 mile turn right at light at stop sign turn left onto 266 Cainesville Pike Rd. go 7 miles to Beech Log Road on Left go approximately 2.3 miles to Never Go Back Ranch (on Left log cabin on top of hill) pass cabin to continue up to barn at top of hill

From Franklin / 840

take exit for Speedway, go right to Murfreesboro Rd at stop sign make left go to 265 Chicken Road go right drive about 6 miles to Cainesville pike rt 265 make right about 1 mile up road make Left on Beech Log Road follow above

From Murfreesboro

Take 96 Lacassas Pike (East) to Cainesville pike Rt 265 (Left) Go 11 miles to Beech Log Road on Right (you will go thru town of Norcross but if you come to Rt 265 you went too far) follow above

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. MACH / PACH ribbons will be awarded to any dog completing their title.

Highest Scoring Puli in each class will be awarded a prize.

PCA will be offering the High Scoring Puli of the trial a 'High Scoring Puli' rosette and a special award. High scoring Puli is determined by:

1. Highest combined score for a Puli qualifying in BOTH a Standard and a JWW class (combined YPS tie breaker)
2. If no double Q, a qualifying run with the Highest Standard class score, with YPS being the tie breaker
3. If no standard qualifier, then the highest score in JWW class, with YPS being the tie breaker
4. If there is no qualifier in either STD or JWW classes, PCA will award the highest T2B score

Waiting list

A waiting list of up to 50 runs will be maintained. Per Chapter 1, Section 16.1 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a "waiting list close date" will be instituted. **The "waiting list close" will be 6 pm, Friday, October 7th.** Full refunds will be given to those exhibitors withdrawing ONLY for the runs that are able to be filled from the waiting list.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through period allows handlers to plan their strategy running the course and will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing.

Notice To Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes may **not** run in a higher height division.
- **Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$5 processing fee per run entered **with a certificate from a veterinarian**.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs**. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean future use.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- NO Concessions will be available on site. Please plan accordingly 30 minutes to nearest fast food restaurant.
- **The show site will be available to exhibitors for set up after 3:00pm on Tuesday. Exhibitors will NOT be allowed to set up in the building before this time. No exceptions.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
